a. *ebrary*

- i. Use "table of contents" features
- ii. Create bookshelves
- iii. Use "highlight" & "share" features
- iv. Download onto other devices
- v. Printing is limited, watch screens for guidelines
- vi. Learn more; ask for help at the Reference Desk

b. *MnPALS PLUS*

- i. Use drop-down menu to select "subject."
- ii. Type author's name, LAST NAME first: e.g., Woolf, Virginia
- iii. OR, add terms and phrases such as:

"Criticism and interpretation"

"History and criticism"

- i. Search title of your work - don't forget quotation marks: e.g., "room of one's own"
- ii. Limit by language
- iii. Limit by source type: book, book article, journal article
